- Letters – letter to/from an evacuee, letters to a soldier serving
- Diaries – of a soldier, evacuee, characters from Goodnight Mr Tom, Anne Frank
- Newspaper reports – declaration of war, bombing of South Shields, local soldier missing
- Explanation texts – preparation for blitz, shelters
- Instructions – how to black out
- Formal speeches – use of language, children speaking to children
- Persuasive Writing – propaganda posters

History

- Timeline of events -main events of the war (Blitz, start of war, Battle of Britain, end of war)
- Comparison of Jewish child and German child (use of Literacy Shed German perspective)
- The Blitz – Battle of Britain, South Shields bombing, safety guide – sirens/Morrison shelters
- School – dress as 1940s, times tables by rote, lunch as would have been, air raid
- Home – 1940s home, list the differences between then and now
- Refugees – what happened after war ended, homelessness

- Countries affected by war
- Location of areas targeted by bombs and reasons why
- Effects on local area
